**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with Craftsman influences built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a bellcast hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. There is a corner wrap-around open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with square wood posts.
