**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1918. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original stucco. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, vertical 3/1 double-hung sashes. There is a two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
