**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1922. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a hip and gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts. Painted brick.
