Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 2-bay domestic building in the English Cottage Revival style with Tudor influences built in 1927. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original brick and original half timbering. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked box cornice, eave brackets and one shed-roofed dormer. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, multi-light paired casement. There is a single-story, single-bay enclosed porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with paired paired brick posts.
