**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the No Primary Style built in 1949. The structural system is frame. The foundation is poured concrete. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a cross-hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one offset left, straddle ridge, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 8/8 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, recessed umbrage characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof.
