This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Eastlake/Folk Victorian style with Folk/Traditional influences built in 1920. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a high hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles. Windows are replacement aluminum, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof with square brick posts.
