Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Bungalow/craftsman style built in 1936. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stone. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice , eave brackets. There is one side left, exterior, stone chimney. Windows are original wood, vertical 3/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with arched stone posts.
