Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Mission/Spanish Revival style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original stucco. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in original terra cotta barrel tile with flush eaves. There is one off center in front, exterior, stuccoed chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay umbrage characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in terra-cotta tiles with arched stuccoed posts.
