Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the English Cottage Revival style with Tudor influences built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay platform/stoop.
