Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
