Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Eclectic style with Exotic Revival influences built in 1926. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a hipped cross gable roof clad in original corrugated tiles with box cornice. Windows are original wood, multi-light double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a hip-and-gable roof clad in pressed/patterned metal with classical wood posts.
