Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Tudor style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1922. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original half timbering. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and three gabled dormers. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are replacement vinyl, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a platform/stoop.
