Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style built in 1925. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. There is a two-story, full-span open porch characterized by a flat with balcony roof with square brick posts.
