This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Mission/Spanish Revival influences built in 1929. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in original terra cotta barrell tile with box cornice and one hiproofed dormer.
