Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in the period 1920-1929. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice , exposed rafters and brackets and one eyebrow dormer. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers.
