Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets and one eyebrow dormer. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers.
