Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Eclectic style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a bellcast gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves and one gabled dormer. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a bellcast gable roof clad in asphalt shingles with decorative brick posts.
