**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the English Cottage Revival style built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick and original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a bellcast gable roof clad in asphalt shingles with arched brick posts.
