**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1921. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets. There are one offset left, straddle ridge, brick chimney and two offset right, rear slope, brick chimneys. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, corner wrap-around open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
