Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with Craftsman influences built in 1916. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked box cornice. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay central open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
