Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style with Eclectic influences built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one side left, side slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, multi-light double-hung sashes. There is a two-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with decorative brick posts.
