Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Georgian style with Greek Revival influences built in 1926. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one offset left, front slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 8/1 double-hung sashes. There is a two-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with classical wood posts on turned wood piers.
