**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Georgian style with Federal influences built in 1926. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and three gabled dormers. There is one offset right, straddle ridge, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a two-story, full-span open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with square wood posts.
