Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style with Georgian influences built in 1929. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in original terra-cotta tiles with box cornice. There is one offset left, side slope, brick chimney. Windows are original, 9/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a flat with balcony roof with square brick posts. An interesting mix of styles.
