Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement synthetic barrel tile asphalt with box cornice. There are one side left, exterior, brick chimney and two side right, exterior, brick chimneys. Windows are replacement vinyl, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in rubberized/asphalt composite with short battered brick posts on square brick piers.
