Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 5-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style built in 1922. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a high hip roof clad in original asbestos shingle with flush eaves. There is one center, straddle ridge, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a rooftop terrace characterized by a flat roof.
