**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1926. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with raked open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets. There is one offset right, straddle ridge, brick chimney. There is a single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with short battered wood posts on square brick piers.
