Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Colonial Revival style with Georgian influences built in 1926. The structural system is frame. The foundation is frame. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a high side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one offset left, straddle ridge, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 9/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-bay umbrage characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with classical wood posts.
