**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Tudor style with English Cottage Revival influences built in 1922. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a cross gable roof clad in original slate with flush eaves. Windows are original wood, multi-light grouped double-hung sash. There is a single-story, single-bay umbrage characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof with arched stone posts.
