Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Mid-Century Modern style built in 1955. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one center, straddle ridge, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, multi-light fixed. There is a single-story, recessed platform/stoop characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles.
