Description/Remarks

This is a 1.5-story, 4-bay domestic building in the Eastlake/Folk Victorian style with Late Victorian influences built in 1915. The structural system is frame. The foundation is piers. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a bellcast cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice , eave brackets and one bellcast hipped dormer. There is one offset left, side slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, corner wrap-around open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with decorative metal posts.
