**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, multiple-bay domestic building in the Renaissance style with Mission/Spanish Revival influences built in 1920. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a multi-plane/complex roof clad in original terra cotta barrel tile with open cornice. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 4/4 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, two-bay open porch characterized by a shed roof clad in terra-cotta tiles with round wood posts on battered brick piers.
