The building has a low side gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves and three gabled dormers. There is one center, side slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/6 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in asphalt shingles with modern turned wood posts.
