**Description/Remarks**

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style built in 1930. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a multi-plane cross gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice , eave brackets. There is one side left, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, Prairie style grid/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
