**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Prairie School style built in 1920. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a low hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. There is one offset left, side slope, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, full-span open porch characterized by a hip roof clad in asphalt shingles with square brick posts.
