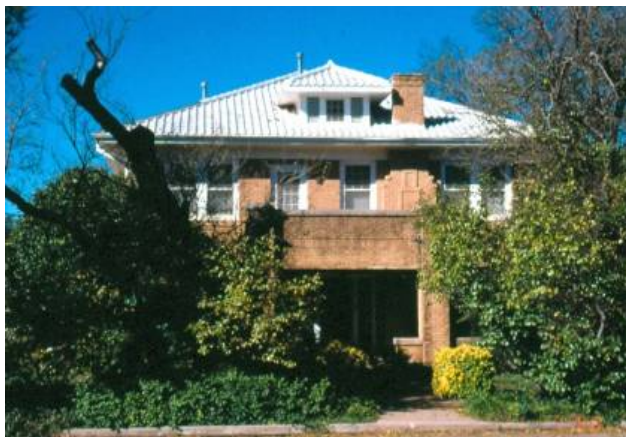

**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Eclectic style with Prairie School influences built in 1926. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick. The building has a hip with center gable roof clad in original pressed/patterned metal with box cornice and one hip-roofed dormer. There is one off center in front, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 6/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a flat with balcony roof with square brick posts.
