Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Late Victorian influences built in 1905. The structural system is undetermined. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a bellcast hip roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with box cornice. There is one side right, exterior, brick chimney. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, corner wrap-around open porch characterized by an integrated (under the main) roof clad in asphalt shingles with battered wood posts on square brick piers. Porch columns are later craftsman style.
