Description/Remarks

This is a 1-story, 2-bay domestic building in the Craftsman style with Bungalow/craftsman influences built in 1926. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a multi-plane front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with open cornice, exposed rafters and brackets. Windows are original wood, vertical 4/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay open porch characterized by a gabled roof clad in asphalt shingles with decorative metal posts.
