Description/Remarks

This is a 2-story, 3-bay domestic building in the Folk/Traditional style with Colonial Revival influences built in 1928. The structural system is frame. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original wood siding. The building has a low front gable roof clad in replacement asphalt shingles with flush eaves. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. There is a single-story, single-bay platform/stoop characterized by a shed roof clad in asphalt shingles with decorative corbel posts.
