**Description/Remarks**

This is a 2-story, 10-bay commercial building in the 19th Century Commercial style with Late Victorian influences built ca. 1906 and 1912. The structural system is wood platform. The foundation is undetermined. Exterior walls are original brick veneer and original brick veneer. The building has a flat with parapet roof clad in an undetermined material. Windows are original wood, 1/1 double-hung sashes. Some of the windows are covered over with a decorative metal plating. This building burned down partially in 1912 and was rebuilt that same year.
